Revitalization Promotion Activities Performed during the Year-end and New Year Period

Since temporary return to or stay in the zone in preparation for having the evacuation order lifted and the zone with restricted entry was allowed during the year-end and New Year period, we engaged in activities such as cleaning shrines, etc. to prepare for New Year's visit and supporting evacuees in returning to their homes upon consulting with the government and municipalities. During the period of 16 days (from Wednesday, December 19, 2012 to Thursday, January 3, 2013), about 1,000 TEPCO employees engaged in revitalization promotion activities such as cleaning in houses in the zone in preparation for having the evacuation order lifted and helping the revitalization support volunteers (regular activities).
