TEPCO has newly designated the miscellaneous solid waste incineration facility as the area where workers can move around in normal work uniforms. The company has also expanded the areas with workers not required to wear protective clothing around the main anti-earthquake building and each contractor building, so that they will be able to move in normal work clothes from the entrance control building to the parking lots for each contractor building, or from a bus stop to any buildings located in the areas.
