Fuel Cost Adjustments, etc. included in Electricity Rates for August 2025

In response to today's announcement of the fuel prices from March 2025 to May 2025 (prices of crude oil, LNG, and coal according to trade statistics), the fuel cost adjustment unit prices and the fuel cost, etc. adjustment unit prices included in the electricity rates for August 2025 have been determined as follows.

Please note that the fuel cost adjustment unit prices and the fuel cost, etc. adjustment unit prices are calculated after discounting 2.00 yen/kWh and 1.00 yen/kWh for low-voltage and high-voltage supply, respectively, for August 2025 and October 2025, and 2.40 yen/kWh and 1.20 yen/kWh for low-voltage and high-voltage supply, respectively, for September 2025 as a nationwide measure to subsidize electricity/gas rates.
