

Fuel Cost Adjustments, etc. included in Electricity Rates for May 2026

In response to today's announcement of the fuel prices from December 2025 to February 2026 (prices of crude oil, LNG, and coal according to trade statistics), the fuel cost adjustment unit prices for low-voltage supply customers included in the electricity rates for May 2026 have been determined as follows.

1. For low-voltage supply customers: Fuel cost adjustment unit prices (tax included)

The electricity rates for May 2026 include the fuel cost adjustment and the unit price of renewable energy power promotion surcharge for FY2026 (4.18 yen/kWh as announced by the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry on March 19, 2026) to be applied to the electricity rates from May 2026.

*6 The rates shown in the table are applicable to the case of 30A of meter-rate lighting B with electricity consumption of 260 kWh/month. They include the renewable energy power promotion surcharge (1,086 yen is the surcharge applicable to electricity rates from May 2026 to April 2027 and 1,034 yen from May 2025 to April 2026.) and a consumption tax and other costs.

*7 Includes an electricity consumption discount of 390 yen (260 kWh x 1.50 yen/kWh) for April 2026 as a nationwide measure for subsidizing electricity/gas rates.

*8 Shows the difference between the electricity rates after reflecting measures to subsidize electricity/gas rates.

*9 If fuel prices/market prices surge due to changes in the global energy situation or tight supply-demand conditions, etc., there is a possibility that the fuel cost adjustment prices/market price adjustment prices may increase significantly.
