Application for an Amendment to the Financial Assistance Amount (23rd Provision) and Approval of Modification to the Special Business Plan

Today, TEPCO submitted an application for an amendment to the financial assistance amount for the 23rd provision to the Nuclear Damage Compensation and Decommissioning Facilitation Corporation (“NDF”) according to Article 43-1 of the Nuclear Damage Compensation Facilitation Corporation Act. Afterward, according to Article 46-1 of the same law, TEPCO together with the NDF submitted an application for approval of modifications to the Special Business Plan approved March 17, 2025, presented as the Fifth Comprehensive Special Business Plan to the competent ministers (Prime Minister and the Minister of the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry) following a resolution of the NDF Steering Committee.

In this application to amend the financial assistance amount, the requested amount was increased by 73 billion 265 million yen due to increase in estimated costs associated with the discharge of ALPS treated water as well as increases from the extension of the calculation period for damages from shipment restriction orders, reputational damages, and other indirect damages.

The TEPCO Group and Group employees will continue to work as one to achieve transformational management reform. By doing so, we aim to secure the funding for compensation and decommissioning as well as increase corporate value as a way to provide peace of mind to the people of Fukushima and those affected by the accident, and gain the understanding of customers as well as the public.
