Seawater contains various substances such as salt and is more viscous than freshwater. Protein skimmers take advantage of this attribute. When air is blown into the water, bubbles are generated, and organic matter, such as feces, adheres to the surface of the bubbles and enabling it to be removed. This is the same principle that produces sea foam that can be seen along the coast of the Sea of Japan in winter.
