Commencement of fuel removal from the Unit 2 spent fuel pool

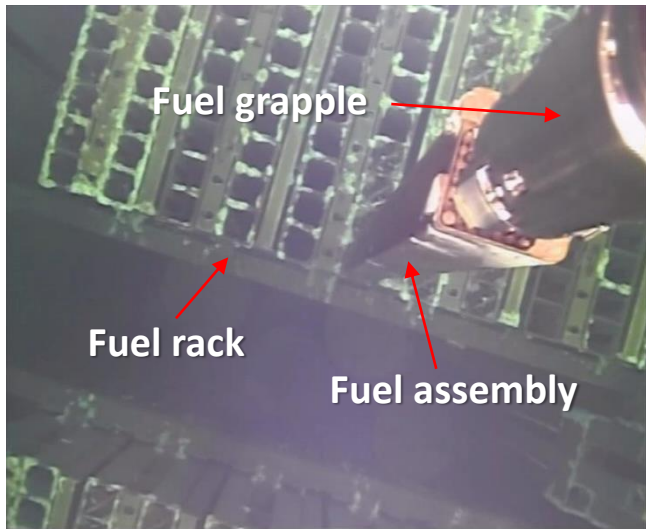
- Removal of the 615 fuel assemblies (spent fuel: 587, fresh fuel: 28) being stored in the Unit 2 spent fuel pool commenced at 12:00 p.m. today (June 2, 2026).
- The completion of the removal is expected in FY2028.
- We will continue to move forward safely as planned.

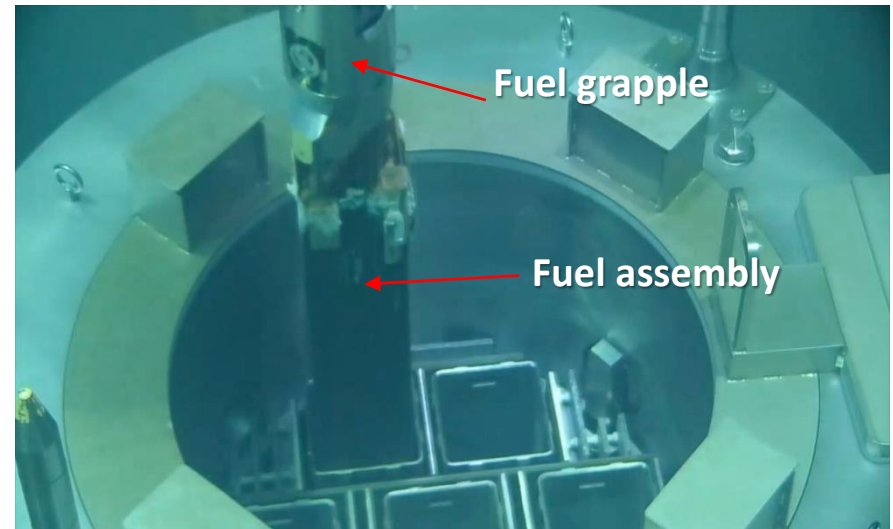
June 7, 2024	Construction of fuel removal work platform completed
May 30, 2025	Fuel handling equipment loaded onto work platform
March 18, 2026	Installation of fuel handling equipment completed
June 2, 2026	Commencement of fuel removal

[Timeline on June 2, 2026]

7:40 a.m.	Preparations commence (Deployment of the enclosure used as a countermeasure to prevent the spread of contamination was initiated)
12:00 p.m.	Removal commences (The first fuel assembly was lifted from the rack)
3:30 p.m.	Completion of the first day's work
