



Disbandment of the Nuclear Reform Monitoring Committee

August 27, 2026

Tokyo Electric Power Company Holdings, Inc.

We hereby inform you that today, the Tokyo Electric Power Company Holdings, Inc. Board of Directors voted to disband the Nuclear Reform Monitoring Committee (hereinafter referred to as, “NRMC”) effective September 30, 2026.

Comprised of experts from Japan and overseas, the NRMC was established on September 11, 2012 as an advisory body to the Board of Directors. It has acted with the objective of monitoring and supervising from an external perspective TEPCO reform initiatives aimed at achieving nuclear power station management that has the world’s highest levels of safety awareness, technological capability, and ability to engage in dialogue with society.

Since establishment of the NRMC its members have drawn upon their plethora of knowledge and expertise to repeatedly discuss [TEPCO initiatives] and have made a monumental contribution to TEPCO’s achievement of nuclear safety reforms.

Whereas it has been deemed that the NRMC has fulfilled its objectives and role, TEPCO has decided to terminate all activities of the NRMC and disband the body.

The invaluable recommendations and opinions elicited from the NRMC shall be leveraged by TEPCO going forward as we further promote nuclear reforms and strive to make continual improvements.
