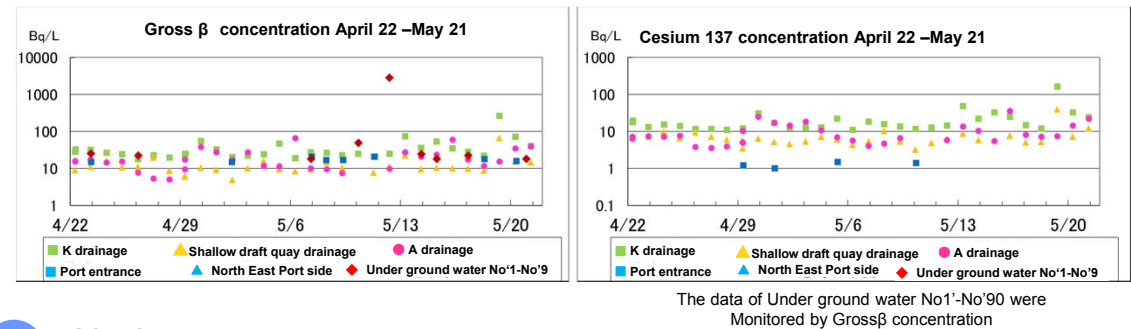


- The number of data relating to the newly posted “Daily Analysis Result of Radioactive Materials” and the continuously posted “Analysis result of Radioactive Materials surrounding the Fukushima Daiichi NPS” measured from April 30 to May 27 totaled approx. 3000.
- During the time, there was no significant fluctuation of figures which would affect the surrounding environment.
- Also the operation of Unit 1 building cover dismantling has began on May 15 and anti-radiation-scattering-agent was sprayed from May 15 up to May 20. During the time there was no significant fluctuation on the Monitoring Post or Dust Monitor values.

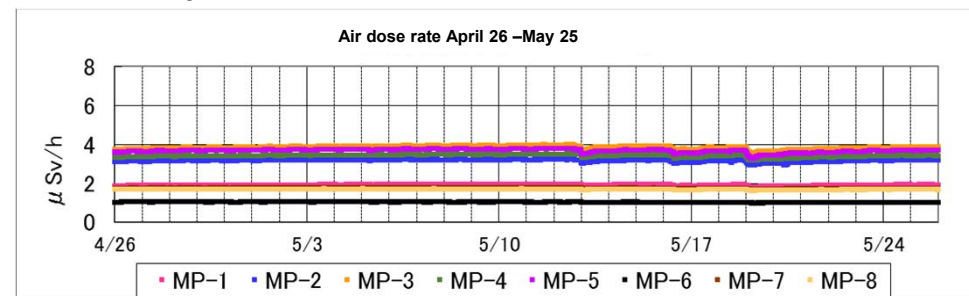
## A Water (Sea water, drainage, underground water)

Temporary rise in data does not indicate accident etc. or significant fluctuation.



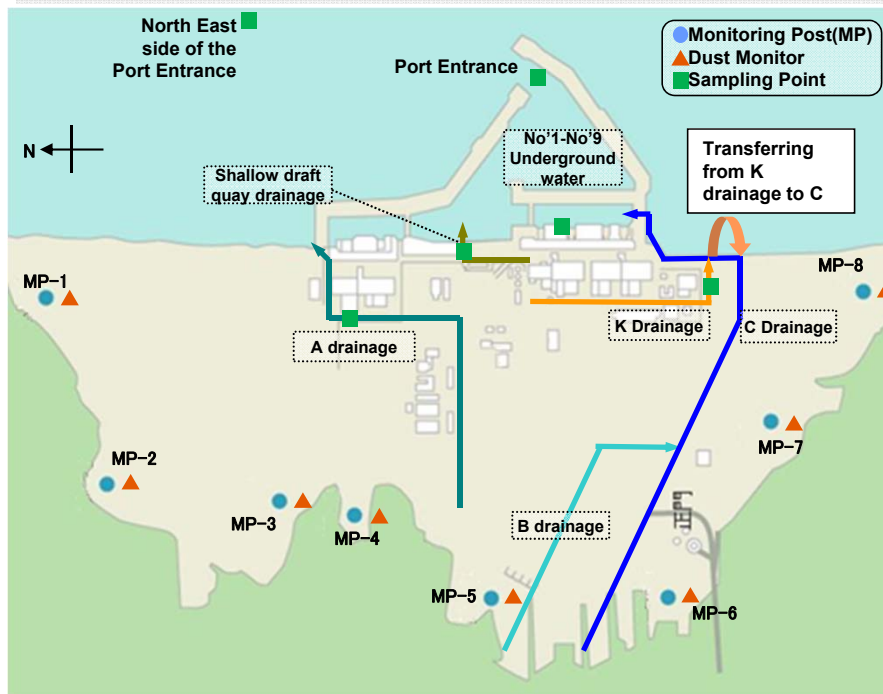
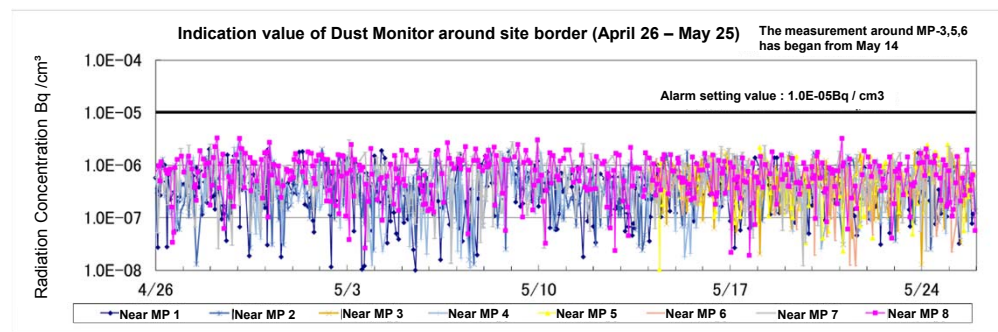
## B Air dose rate
