The status of evaluation of doses for workers in charge of the emergency works at Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station

- detailed measurement for workers exceeding 20mSv -

We are continuing measurement and evaluation of exposure doses for workers in charge of the emergency works at Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station.

We are having workers with over 20mSv measured in detail at JAEA.

On July 13, we reported the exposure doses of workers who were checked by WBC with the internal exposure doses exceeding 100mSv. This time, we report the status of evaluation and determination of doses for workers with the internal exposure doses of "over 50mSv and less or equal to 100mSv" (Table 1).

## Report

As a result of reevaluation such as detailed measurement by JAEA on workers with the internal exposure doses of "over 50mSv and less or equal to 100mSv", the number of persons changed from the last report (July 13), 94 (TEPCO workers: 88, Contractors: 6) to 64 (TEPCO workers: 38, Contractors: 26) (Table 2).

(At the time of reports on June 20 and 30, the number of persons was 157. 94 was as a result of reevaluation such as detailed measurement by JAEA.)
